- 1. Baronnie de Coussergues Rouge**  
Vin de Pays des Côtes de Thongue  
*A blend of Merlot, Cabernet and Mourvèdre, this is a wine of good structure, with a variety of flavours on the palate. Satisfying and smooth.*
- 2. Château La Bastide Corbières**  
Guilhelm Durand, Escales  
70% Syrah 10% Grenache 20% Carignan  
*A very attractive wine with a lovely deep cherry colour and a rich complex nose. Firm in structure it is rich and powerful with elegant tannins*
- 3. Côtes du Ventoux**  
Delas Frères, St-Jean-de-Muzols  
*This is a fresh, fruity and easy-to-drink wine from the Ventoux, well worth trying.*
- 4. Merlot Les Bateaux Vin de Pays d'Oc**  
Jacques & François Lurton  
*A fine Southern Merlot, well balanced and warm in taste with red berry flavours. with a good finish*
- 5. Drostdy-Hof Cape Red**  
Drostdy-Hof Wineries  
*The wine is deep ruby in colour, medium to full bodied, silky smooth on the palate with a lingering finish.*
- 6. St Germain Vin de Pays de Vaucluse Red**  
*This light and fruity wine, produced in the South of the Rhône Valley is soft, supple and round. Serve at room temperature with salads, all types of meat and cheese.*
- 7. De Martino Cabernet-Sauvignon**  
De Martino Vineyard, Maipo Valley, Chile  
*A pleasing estate bottled Chilean wine made from the Cabernet Sauvignon grape, full bodied and showing plenty of ripe red fruit tastes. Excellent quality*

- 8. Domaine Peirière Chardonnay**  
Paul Sapin.  
*A well made Chardonnay with good body and fine buttery aroma.*
- 9. Piesporter Michelsberg QbA**  
Helenen Kellerei, Longuich-Mosel  
*A lovely crisp Mosel, good balance with a nice touch of sweetness and fruit.*
- 10. Drostdy-Hof Steen Chenin Blanc**  
Drostdy-Hof Wineries, Tulbagh  
*The wine is clear and straw in colour. It has an earthy, subtly fruity nose. It is dry and medium bodied, with a good acid balance and a pleasant lingering finish.*
- 13. St Germain Vin de Pays de Gascogne**  
*This aromatic dry white is made from the two most popular varieties from the South West of France: Colombard and Ugni-blanc. Dry with a delicate bouquet. Ideal as a refreshing apéritif or with all lightly flavoured foods.*
- 14. De Martino Sauvignon Blanc**  
De Martino Vineyards, Maipo Valley  
*A white estate bottled wine made from the Sauvignon Blanc grape, with a spicy nettley flavour, both on the nose and palate.*
